

Streetbuild is committed to providing a quality service in a manner that minimises our potential impact on the environment. We will operate in compliance with all relevant environmental legislation and will strive to use pollution prevention and environmental best practices in all we do.

Streetbuild Management Responsibilities:

- Ensure Streetbuild's personnel operate in adherence and in compliance of relative current Acts and subordinate legislation.
- Ensure workers have been adequately trained and resourced to undertake their duties and responsibilities accordingly.
- Encourage workers to carry out their work in an environmentally responsible manner.
- Keep abreast of changes and new developments in policy and legal requirements.
- Demonstrate and communicate responsibilities to all workers.
- Exercise control of actions by contractors that may impact on the environment on Streetbuild project sites.
- Ensure all personnel are aware of applicable procedures.
- Endeavour to continually improve Streetbuild's environmental performance aiming to minimise any social impact and damage from activities, by periodically reviewing our environmental policy in light of our current and planned future activities.
- Consider environmental issues in making operational decisions.

Workers Responsibilities:

- Work carefully at all times to protect the environment.
- Report any environmental impacts, hazards or potential environmental management issues of which they become aware to management or supervisor, including poorly installed or poorly operating equipment they encounter in the workplace/project site.
- Work in a manner consistent with the Streetbuild's legal environmental obligations.
- Comply with all policies and procedures so to ensure that services are provided with minimal impact to the environment.

In the company's commitment to the Environment Streetbuild will ensure to:

- Reduce waste through re-use and recycling and by purchasing recycled, recyclable or re-furnished products and materials where these alternatives are available, economical and suitable.
- Promote efficient use of materials and resources throughout our facility including water, electricity, raw materials and other resources, particularly those that are non-renewable.
- Choose projects that can be achieved in an environmentally responsible manner.
- Develop relationships with suppliers who demonstrate a similar commitment.
- Implement processes on all sites to minimise waste and prevent pollution.
- Establish measurable objectives and targets to take environmental performance beyond compliance.
- Avoid unnecessary use of hazardous materials and products, seek substitutions when feasible, and take all reasonable steps to protect human health and the environment when such materials must be used, stored and disposed of.
- Purchase and use environmentally responsible products accordingly.
- Work towards reducing Streetbuild's carbon footprint.

This policy applies to all persons working for, or on behalf of Streetbuild. It is the responsibility of the Streetbuild management team to provide resources and promote this policy to ensure its effective implementation.
